### COURSE DURATION:

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### WHAT ARE THE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

There are no prerequisites, however it is preferred that students:

- Are 18 years or older
  - Have sound language and literacy skills (at least Year 10 English, or equivalent)
  - Have basic computer skills
  - Oral communication - a learner will be able to use and respond to spoken language including some unfamiliar material within a variety of contexts
  - Numeracy and mathematics - a learner will be able to recognise and use a variety of conventions and symbolism of formal mathematics or
  - Due to the physical requirements of this course, the student must be physically fit
  - Commitment to completing the mandatory 120 hours practical placement (unpaid)
- Ability to obtain a Clear National Police Check at the students' cost
  - Police check showing a serious conviction of murder, sexual assault or a conviction and a sentence to imprisonment for any other form of assault will not allow entry in our Certificate III in Individual Support
  - Global International College will only accept students with a clear police check



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### WHAT ARE THE RESOURCES NEEDED TO COMPLETE THE COURSE?

To support you in your new course with Global International College, we will provide:

- Learner Guides, Assessment Workbooks, and other course materials
  - Document templates, handouts and other helpful resources
  - A simulated environment with organisation policies, procedures and other documentation for learners who do not have access to a workplace (excluding vocational placement)
  - Full Trainer Support
  - Access to relevant Acts, regulations and standards
- Guidance and assistance in arranging access to a Registered Aged Care Facility to complete vocational placement

To complete your course you will need to arrange access to:

- A Computer (PC or Mac) with Internet (a minimum speed of 5mbps is recommended)

- Latest Adobe Acrobat Reader and Adobe Flash Player
- Latest Microsoft Word, Powerpoint and Excel
- Camera or video recorder
- 1 passenger vehicle
- 3 volunteers for role play tasks (may be friends, family members, colleagues, etc.)

### Assessment Methods:

- Questioning which include self-assessment, verbal answers, written questionnaires, activity modules or interview
- Portfolio, simulated scenarios, projects, and case studies
- Observation during on-the-job or role play/simulation



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### VOCATIONAL PLACEMENT

Global International College will guide and assist you in arranging a vocational placement position of 120 hours minimum with an approved and regulated aged care facility. This process begins as soon as your enrolment has been confirmed.

Initial engagements with new contact aged care centres will be facilitated through GIC's Vocational Placement Pack which outlines all the requirements for finding a suitable Vocational Placement Provider that will facilitate the required workplace assessments and allow learners to complete the required vocational placement hours. ### WHAT ARE THE QUALIFICATION PATHWAYS AFTER TAKING THE COURSE?

The Certificate III in Individual Support (CHC33015) is suitable for anyone looking to enter the aged care industry, and seeking to gain employment at an entry level.
